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What Happens If Your Student Receives a Head Injury During A School Event?

Ш	Injury Checklist by a trained athletic coach will immediately be completed on the student.
	If the head injury happens during the school day, evaluation will be given by school personnel using <u>CDC Concussion Signs and Symptoms</u> <u>Checklist</u> and/or call home to notify guardians of head injury.
	If a student is exhibiting any signs and symptoms of a concussion, guardians will be contacted and advised to have their student evaluated by a healthcare provider.
	Healthcare provider evaluates and fills out the learn/return to sports paperwork which is sent to the school. This paperwork will be used to create an individualized care plan for your students' unique needs as they recover from their concussion.
	Working in partnership, the parents, healthcare providers, student, parents, and the staff of MVSD, an individualized plan will be created for your student. Communication will be continued until the student is cleared, per healthcare provider, to return, with no restrictions, to academics and athletics.
