Student Forums

The SDP-Heights Partnership to host Student Forums is a new citywide initiative designed to amplify student voice and leadership across Philadelphia. Beginning in the 2025–26 school year, middle and high school students will participate in four forums focused on issues such as affinity groups, youth leadership, mental health, and inclusion. Students will then carry forward "Impact Initiatives" at the school and network level, culminating in a District Impact Summit where they present their work to educators, community leaders, and peers. This initiative will give students meaningful opportunities to shape school culture, influence decision-making, and improve well-being and academic outcomes across the district.
