## For the following examples...

Let's assume the minimum passing score is 75%.

How this was calculated:

Let's assume your region is Mississippi.

Using this chart, we know that the minimum passing score for this exam in Mississippi is 149. We divide that number by 200. So,  $149 \div 200 = 74.5$ , rounded up to 75%.
