I have experience in this position, having served three times as a member of ADEM and previously as a member of the San Mateo County DCC when my Assembly district was solely in San Mateo County.

I have served as a Jefferson Union High School District Board member for 12 years and just stepped down in December. I currently serve as the Chair of the San Mateo County Independent Civilian Advisory Committee for the Sheriff's Office, the Co-Founder of the REACH Coalition a group of elected officials of color and community-based organizations run by people of color in pursuit of true community health and equity, Vice President of the SMC NAACP, the Board of the Housing Leadership Council of SMC, the Board of the Northern California Branch of the ACLU, Chair of San Mateo County's Pride Parade, Board of the Daly City Public Library Associates. It is a lot, but I am here to serve and say the things that need to be said and are often ignored in my community.

In San Mateo County and, more specifically, Daly City, almost everything I do challenges an established power structure. The example I will use is the ADEM race. Daly City is the largest city in San Mateo County (we were undercounted in the last census due to Trump not funding the extended count, which puts us past Redwood City every census), the densest and most diverse. I thought being a part of North County in the San Mateo County power dynamics was hard until I my city was put into AD19 with San Francisco. We are essentially erased. Folks will campaign for ADEM with an AD19 logo of the district that is only San Francisco and not Daly City & SSF. So, I went to meetings with SF Democratic leaders and complained. I speak up whenever I receive an email or application like this one for ADEMs that is entirely focused on San Francisco and does not include San Mateo County. And the result is that we are slowly moving from an afterthought to being embraced as part of the ADEM 19 family. We matter just as much as San Franciscans.

- 8. There are approximately 16,000 people living with HIV in San Francisco. 74% are over the age of 50. 1 in 6 are unstably housed, at risk of losing their housing, or homeless. In addition, the #1 cause of death among those with HIV in the city is overdose. The Republicans in Congress are looking to cut Ryan White funding by more than half. Given that San Francisco has a world-renowned reputation for providing the best HIV care in the country, how will you identify candidates who would address potential funding cuts, and will you support them? I have yet to see any leader win re-election with this level of inflation. We are also a party of fear and reaction. We are afraid of our own shadow and not upsetting "working-class voters," which is a dog whistle for white men in the middle of America. Democrat's policies are no better for the average middle-class person than Republicans.

Universal healthcare would solve so many problems. Not just passing but ensuring that we effectively communicate what we are doing so Americans understand. Letting the name Obamacare stick was an error. Not backing away from the investment in green jobs. Cutting industrial complex spending a reinvesting in job development and education. We were not talking about any of those things. Instead, we were hoisting up Liz Cheney and calling Trump a fascist. He is but we need a solid plan for the "working class" voters.

The US Department of Education's dissolution would cause fiscal and some support issues for certain districts in the state. However, since our CA Ed code is often much tighter in terms of protections for marginalized youth, I really worry about states like Tennessee and Arkansas, with the loss of federal oversight that they really need. Public education will survive this Trump term just like it did last. It is the empowered Republican governors and legislators in red states that have been and will continue to be the real challenge to public education.

We need to fund education in California at levels that match Massachusetts and New York. Our per-pupil spending continues to lag behind. We also need to invest in school infrastructure. Most districts are using buildings that are 40 to 50 years old, if not older.
