 - Always check the log files!
 - Errors, crashes Apache, maybe memory?
 - Things that attach themselves to php will still run (threads?), in a batch context it may try to index and crash
 - Disable solr as a way to stop it

 - Rollback feature in workbench config file
- Not using Workbench?
 - FL need to do some metadata remediation; do a data snapshot; but what have others done?
- Anyone using an XML-based migration?
 - DGI using foxml as baseline and x-pathing into Drupal fields (becoming open source on this)
- Islandora failing on rebuild?
 - Only on permissions? Error message doesn't always line up to actual issue; have to dig around?
