 - i. Volunteers for events
 - Mr. Biggs mentioned that we need more volunteers for these events
 - 1. First semester: Trunk or Treat (Wed. October 23 5-7pm), Holiday Store (Week of the 9th-13th of December)
 - We will have PTO on Dec. 9th and work on setting up for the Holiday Store (5-7 PM in the Library.)
 - ii. Co-Chair for PTO sponsored events
 - iii. Dine & Donate (Fairview vs. Fairview PTO) *Only PTO
 - Starting the year off strong. We ended the year with 3000 more than we started with.
 - Comparing year to year: Majority of sponsors are either new or connected to someone in PTO. Having a good base will help give us more ideas for sponsorship this year.
 - Note about carnival: Amazon wish list for the school brought in \$400 in donations and goods. We can look into utilizing this more this year.
 - Passive income doesn't affect people's spending in ways they wouldn't already spend: Boxtops. Kroger rewards, skate night, etc. These are a good amount of our income and social media is important for spreading awareness.
 - We no longer receive monthly or quarterly checks from Gather for card sales, but this will be addressed later in the meeting.
 - Holiday Store: Very active, purchased additional items which caused more expense to PTO than in years past.
 - Dine and Donate: Great first event at Mother Bears \$350.
 Attaching PTO PayPal QR code to the dine and donate helps bring in additional funds
 - Teacher Appreciation was great, but required more funds and

- work than in previous years.
- Question from Ms. Konwest about Pizza X. We are checking with them to see if there will be a check from the summer.
- Mr. Biggs mentioned that several of our donors are still planning to help this year.
- Ms. Norris mentioned that PTO has been a good steward of funds and we should continue to do our best to share the load and make sure we continue to do so.
- Mr. Gobert mentioned that the personal donor who purchased doughnuts for the monthly "wildcat wagon" will no longer be doing so and wondered if PTO might fund this. Ms. Black mentioned that we have donor funds for this purpose. Ms. Krigler volunteered to pick them up. - PTO will cover the doughnuts for Sept. if we can't find a donor.
