

Discipline Plan

Dear Parents,

When a child does not demonstrate appropriate behavior they will receive a THINK SHEET (example on back). The student is placed in a different classroom or the hall to fill out this form. This allows the child to have time to reflect upon his/her actions and how they can improve. The teacher and student then talk about the behavior and what consequences should follow according to the infraction. These forms are taken home, signed by a parent, and returned to the teacher the following day. Your signature indicates that you have discussed this with your child. If they are returned without a parent signature, the student misses recess until the Think Sheet is returned.

Think Sheets are given for large and small infractions alike. Many times students don't realize how their actions affect the class as a whole. Not all Think Sheets should be a major concern to you, nor are they considered major concerns to us. However, they serve as gentle reminders of appropriate behavior in 6th grade. I appreciate your help in assisting us solve minor problems that make a difference.

Three Think Sheets, no matter the infraction, will count as a STRIKE against them. A strike constitutes a parent/teacher/student conference. If a child receives three strikes, they will be ineligible for field trips, parties, and celebrations.

I really appreciate your support and efforts to encourage positive behavior. I do not foresee any problems and look forward to an exciting year with your children. If you have any questions or concerns, please write them on the form below.
