


Other At-Home Chromebook Tips For MCS Students

1. To Resolve Common Issues

Reboot the Chromebook: I know most of you and I know what you do when you 'think' you are shutting the chromebook down: you shut the lid or log off. This is not shutting the chromebook down.

So if you are having issues with your chromebook be sure reboot the chromebook first before doing anything else by either:

- a. Clicking on the taskbar and then clicking on the  button. Then close the lid and open it again to start it back up. Then log-in.
- b. Or by holding the Power Button down for approximately 30 seconds....(until it shuts down)....then closing the lid and opening it back up again to start it up. Then log-in.

2. If your chromebook does not seem to connect to your wifi or seems to be having wifi issues...(I'm guessing at this point you are reading this with another device)...

- a. Click on the taskbar (where the time is shown)
- b. Now click on the small down arrow in the wifi icon...(upper left hand corner)
- c. Toggle the little button to the right of "Wifi" off...wait a few seconds then toggle it back on.
- d. If this does not work then contact Mr. Peavey.
