




# QUICK GUIDE TO OPERATORS

Using BOOLEAN operators to program a database for you search!

<b>AND</b>	<b>narrows a search, bringing together the different aspects of a topic.</b>	<p><b>AND</b></p>  <p>Both terms</p>
<b>OR</b>	<b>use to make sure you retrieve synonymous and like terms</b>	<p><b>OR</b></p>  <p>Either term</p>
<b>NOT</b>	<b>use to eliminate words or phrases from your search</b>	<p><b>NOT</b></p>  <p>Just one term</p>
<b>Symbols such as * or ?</b>	<b>use wildcard symbols at the end of root words to expand a search</b>	<p><b>E.g. nation* yields nation, nations, national, etc.</b></p> <p><b>E.g. wom?n yields woman and women</b></p>
<b>Combining Boolean Connectors</b>	<b>Combine the boolean connectors with parentheses to create more complicated, precise searches</b>	<p><b>E.g. (donut OR doughnut) AND happiness</b></p>
