The abstract must be written in 250-300 words. The abstract must not contain lengthy background information and have no reference to figure, table, equation, any bibliographical reference either coming within or another article. The language of abstract must be clear and concise. It is a stand-alone summary in one paragraph.

Keywords: Keywords consist of important/ specific words or phrases found mainly in the title and abstract. But it can also come from the article. There are 3-5 keywords from one article. Keywords separated by ";"

## Introduction

It consists of background, research objectives, theories, methods, and contributions to research results that have been carried out. Writing the entire article should use Adobe Garamond Pro font 12-Regular Size (or italics according to the language used). The first line of each paragraph indents by 8 mm. The space used is 1 space.

Citation of sources should use the Harvard system (belly notes) with the Mendeley system, not use footnotes. To use Mendeley in writing bibliographies and citations, you can use the following methods: (1) Run Mendeley Desktop, (2) Click the Tools menu >> Install LibreOffice Plugin, (3) Run LibreOffice Writer, the Mendeley toolbar will appear, (4) Open the document to be cited, (5) Start citing by clicking the "Insert Citation" toolbar, type the name of the reference in the small window that appears or click "Go to Mendeley", (6) Continue by selecting the cited reference, click "Cite" on the Mendeley toolbar, (7) Look back at your LibreOffice, references have been added automatically, (8) To add a bibliography or bibliography, click "Insert Bibliography" on the LibreOffice toolbar, and (9) Done.

#### Discussion

This is the most free part for authors to express. Do not elaborate, but argue logically. In discussing it, review the research that fulfills the research objectives. Connect findings with observations or results of previous research by pointing out similarities and discussing differences.

When displaying a table, the table placement is above or below the text, not in the middle of the text. For that, avoid using the word "....like the table below" but use the word "see table 1" Tables can be included with the format as in table 1 (using only 1 column of page width) or table 2 (using 2 full page columns).

In creating a table, not all the lines in the figure, but only the head of the table and the last part of the table. The correct way to make a table can be seen in table 1, while the wrong table can be seen in table 2. Below the table must be accompanied by an explanation from where the data was obtained.
