

A Level Drama: Year 12 Summer Task

Your only task is to watch and evaluate a piece of live theatre. This can be something taking place locally or further afield or a digital production (see details below).

Your evaluation should be between **500-700 words** and cover some of the following:

- an overview of the storyline and details of the performance (director, lead actor etc)
- evaluation of two key moments you felt were particularly engaging or impressive
- evaluation of two production elements of your choice e.g., costume, set, sound or lighting.



Please don't worry about using a particular structure at this stage, your ideas and enthusiasm are what we are looking for!

National Theatre online:

If you find it difficult to find some live performance over the summer, a really good option is to watch one of the National Theatre productions online (**see details below**). All the plays are quite adult/challenging and I would recommend googling the play in advance and getting an understanding of the plot and main characters.

There are a variety of brilliant productions to choose from but some really good options are listed below. All the plays are listed in alphabetical order on the platform.

- **WUTHERING HEIGHTS**- (Billy Piper plays the lead role in this classic tragedy, set in modern London)
- **ONE MAN TWO GOVERNORS**- (James Corden stars in this chaotic comedy)
- **WUTHERING HEIGHTS**- (A Lively physical theatre adaptation of the novel with song and dance)
