"This is a multi-stall restroom open to everyone. CMU supports an individual's choice of restroom"



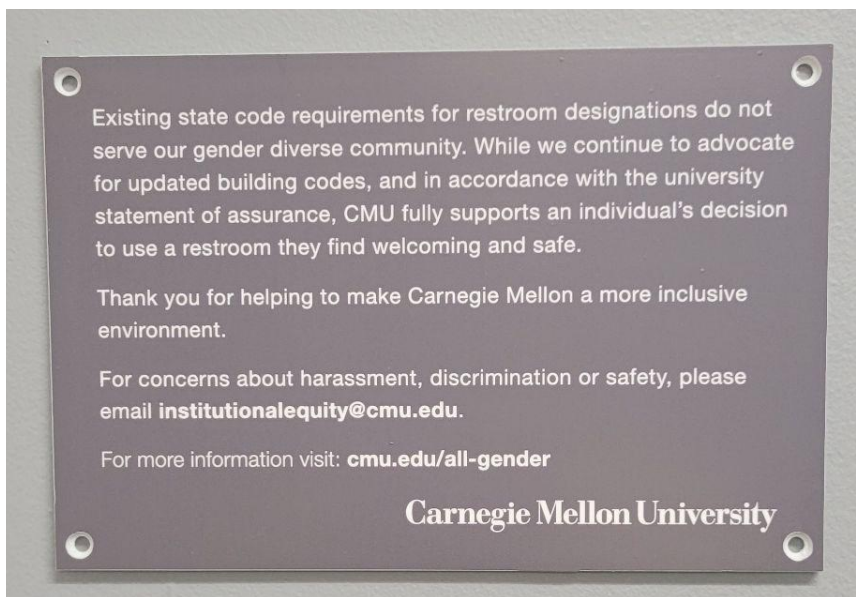
Sign 2
