

Midway Middle Military Family FAQs

Enrollment and Registration:

What steps do I need to take to get my child registered for Midway Middle?

Families can enroll online or in person. Many military families prefer to use online enrollment for a more timely process when moving into our district. Enrollment can be completed online through the Sampson County Schools website at www.sampson.k12.nc.us.

- *Scroll down and click the “ENROLLMENT” icon
- *On the New Student Enrollment page, click the button for “Online Enrollment”
- *Continue with the enrollment process as instructed in the system

A list of required items for enrollment are also listed at the bottom of the New Student Enrollment page. Please make sure to review items that will be needed to complete the online enrollment process. Many of them can be uploaded directly during the online enrollment process. If families have any trouble with the uploading process, they are welcome to bring those items by school and copies can be made.

Hard copy packets are available at the schools for those without internet access or that prefer pen/paper enrollment.

What is required for enrollment grades 6-8?

All students in grades 6-8th grade are required to provide the following documents for enrollment:

- *Certified birth certificate
- *Parent/Guardian ID
- *Current proof of residency such as a water/electric bill, with your name and address on it, lease, mortgage.
- *If applicable, any custody or legal paperwork

Student record of immunizations must be provided within the first 30 days of enrollment. More recent report cards or transcripts and withdrawal grades are also very beneficial, but can be obtained from the previous school if parent/guardian does not have them on hand. First time enrollments to a NC school will be required to submit an NC health assessment within the first 30 days of enrollment. Forms can be obtained from the school nurse.

When is the early college application period/can an incoming student apply for early college?

There is a limited window available for entrance into an early college program during the 8th grade school year. The application window for this program is normally mid-October through the first of December. If you are enrolling an 8th grader that is interested during this application window, contact the school counselor for more information.

Transition into Sampson County Schools:

We have other children to enroll as well, where will they attend if they are in elementary or high school?

There are three elementary feeder schools in the Midway District—Clement, Midway and Plain View. MMS staff can help you determine which elementary school siblings would attend once they know your physical address. Plain View serves areas closer to Dunn/Harnett Co, Clement serves areas closer to Autryville/Cumberland Co, and Midway serves areas right around Spiveys Corner between the other two schools.

All students from MMS go to Midway High School, so any high school siblings would attend there.

Academic Support in Sampson County Schools:

Is there a point of contact for military parents who have students who are AIG or have IEPs, 504s or other special needs?

We encourage you to reach out directly to the school. Each school has an IEP case manager, 504 coordinator, AIG lead teachers, a school nurse and a school counselor who will be able to assist you with what they will need to ensure that your child receives comparable services. It is helpful if you can bring a current copy of the IEP and/or 504 with your child's school records. If not, we will request it from their previous school.

What is covered under the Military Interstate Child Compact Commission (MIC-3)?

The MIC-3 is a loose set of guidelines that were adopted by all 50 states plus Washington D.C to ensure that military-connected students graduate on time with their peers. It covers many different topics such as transfer of education records and enrollment, graduation, placement and attendance, eligibility, and oversight, enforcement and dispute resolution.
