Important Programming Update

In the meantime, we are planning a **one-day Procedures Conference in April 2026**, offering **limited exhibition opportunities**. This focused skills-based event will not replace the breadth of our traditional conference.

Both the Women's Health Conference (November 2025) and the Procedures Conference (April 2026) are being planned in collaboration with the Saint Anselm College School of Nursing to ensure high-quality continuing education.
