In the meantime, we are planning a **one-day Procedures Conference in April 2026**, offering **limited exhibition opportunities**. This focused skills-based event will not replace the breadth of our traditional conference.

Both the **Women's Health Conference (November 2025)** and the **Procedures Conference (April 2026)** are being planned in collaboration with the **Saint Anselm College School of Nursing** to ensure high-quality continuing education.

Looking ahead, with the change in our programming year, we anticipate offering **multiple opportunities for our members and partners to come together, engage, and learn**, while continuing to build on the strong reputation of our **Annual Conference** as one of the premier NP events in the Northeast.
