Directions to Clovis North Educational Center: The Clovis North Educational Center is located in northeast Fresno.
FROM THE NORTH: From CA-99 South take exit 142 toward Grantland Ave. Go 0.3 mi. Take the first left onto West Herndon Ave. Go 10.6 miles. Turn left onto North Willow Ave. Go 3.5 miles. Turn left onto East International Ave. The Clovis North Educational Center will be on your right.

FROM THE SOUTH: From CA-99 North merge onto CA-41 North via exit 131 toward Airport/Yosemite. Go 2.7 mi. Merge onto CA-180 East via exit 128A toward Airport/Kings Canyon. Go 1.1 mi. Merge onto CA-168 East via exit 60A toward Clovis/Huntington Lake. Go 4.2 mi. Take the Shaw Ave. exit. Turn right onto East Shaw Ave. Go 0.3 mi. Take the first left onto Willow Ave. Go 5.6 mi. Turn left onto East International Ave. The Clovis North Educational Center will be on your right.

Clovis North Educational Center Parking: Parking is available in the student lots on the Clovis North Educational Center. Please use these lots located on the southeast and southwest corners of the Center. Parking along the north access road will be for officials only. Buses should use the access road off Willow and immediately turn left/south and drop teams off just past the tennis courts in the pull out area on the right. Then proceed to the large parking lot off International and Chestnut Ave. on the west end of campus.

Clovis North Educational Center Facilities: No locker or showers will be available, so please have your athletes come to the meet dressed to compete. Restroom facilities will be available in the building adjacent to the track (near the finish line), between the baseball and softball stadiums, as well as across the access road from the track (adjacent to the outdoor basketball courts). Several portable restrooms will also be provided. Please refer to the map for restroom locations.

Clovis North Cross-Country Course: The course is an on-campus 2 mile course that is flat and fast, with one hill that ascends out of a pedestrian tunnel after descending into the tunnel. The majority of the first mile is on grass with some decomposed granite, while the second mile is a combination of grass and pavement, with the last 300 meters finishing on the track. The races will be run in the evening under the lights.

Check-In Time and Location: Pick up your team packets at the "TEAM CHECK-IN" area near entry gate to the track starting at 4:00pm. If you arrive after 5:00pm, please pick up packets at the team building adjacent to the track.

Course Walk Through: The course will be available for your walk-through until ten minutes prior to the start of the first race.

Entry Information: Please refer to the *last two pages* of this information packet and follow the On-Line Entry Instructions for Athletic.net as soon as possible TO SECURE YOUR SPOT. (We may be limited on space!). **The ENTRY DEADLINE will be Sunday, October 18, 2026 at 11:59pm.**

Entry Fees: \$15/athlete or \$600/team max. (high school); \$250/team max. (jr. high school)

Make checks payable to *Clovis North High School*. **All entry fees are due by race day. You will not be able to receive your team packet until fees have been paid. Please DO NOT try to pay on-line thru Athletic.net. You may also send checks WELL IN ADVANCE OF THE MEET to:**

If absolutely necessary, school checks, personal checks, and/or cash are acceptable for entry fee payment on the day of the meet. Please do not be rude to our staff at the check-in table if you have forgotten your check or the check was not mailed soon enough. We will need a personal check to hold until your school check arrives. We have found that if we don't do this, we have to repeatedly contact school Athletic Directors to get the check after the meet is completed.

Meet Schedule: THIS SCHEDULE IS *TENTATIVE* AND IS SUBJECT TO CHANGE BASED ON THE NUMBER OF ATHLETES ATTENDING! At the conclusion of the last race, the top Varsity Girls and Varsity Boys teams will be given awards, to be determined by the combined time of the top 5 runners from each team's varsity runners. Small Schools and Large Schools Awards will be sorted from the results. In the case of a tie, the fastest no. 6 runner will determine the winning team. Jr. High race scoring will be by the standard method.

Race Classifications: **DUE TO TIME CONSTRAINTS, WE MUST LIMIT THE JR. HIGH RACES TO THOSE ATHLETES WHO CAN RACE 2 MILES IN UNDER 18:00.** Frosh/Soph entrants should be composed of those freshmen and sophomore athletes who do not qualify as part of your top 7 varsity team members. **ANY FROSH/SOPH BOY RUNNERS WHO ARE NOT ABLE TO RUN UNDER 18:00 FOR 2 MILES MUST BE PLACED IN THE JV DIVISION.**

This is in order to keep the meet running on time. Failure to do this could result in your athlete not receiving a time/place. Junior Varsity Boys entrants should be composed of those junior and senior athletes who do not qualify as part of your top 7 varsity team members **as well as any frosh/soph athletes who are unable to complete 2 miles in under 18:00.**

Small School/Large School divisions (high schools only) will be roughly based on 2025-2026 CBEDS. We will designate approx. half of the teams as Large Schools and the other half, approximately, as Small Schools for *team* awards purposes only.

Awards: Individual awards will be distributed to the “top finishers,” regardless of school size designation, as they exit the finish chute. Team awards will be announced and distributed at the conclusion of the meet or as close to the conclusion of each race as possible. See schedule for who receives awards.

T-shirts and Refreshments: Meet t-shirts will be available for \$25 and a snack bar, as well as food truck items, will be available for a nominal fee.

Follow instructions on the meet registration page to enter your athletes into the appropriate division(s).
