Purpose: A simple record tool that allows you to save, review and send auto recording.

Advantage: You can save the audio file or post it through facebook and twitter using a link. In addition, there is a link that you can copy and paste.

Disadvantage: It is only for audio recording, not video. The link only lasts thirty days, however the saved file is good forever.

Opinion: I think this is a great tool that I would use in my online classroom because it is a useful tool that shares a voice recording in a quick and easy way. In addition, , this tool can be used in an online classroom when teachers want to record their lesson and share with their students.

Opinion: This tool seems to be a little less complicated that MiHistro, which is helpful. I would use this an online classroom as an "All about me" project where I can get a rapport of the students!

Disadvantage: The most powerful tools on this website need to be bought.

Opinion: Since the video can be worked on at the same time as other students, I think it would be a useful tool in an online classroom for a project. In my online classroom I would assign my student partners to work on a project for a summative assessment.

Disadvantage: Unless you click the button to make the video private, than everyone can see it. Opinion: I think this tool may be used used in an online classroom for a project.
