Memory verse: If any of you needs wisdom, you should ask God for it. He will give it to you. God gives


freely to everyone and doesn't find fault. (James 1:5) Life Question: Why do I need wisdom from God?

Kids spot

Intro

Welcome children and start by asking children if they remember what they learnt on Sunday. Quick recap by reading the Memory Verse together.

- 1) Discuss what was taught on Sunday
- Print the following image found at https://www.biblefunforkids.com/2014/02/solomons-wisdom.html



- Recap the story from 1 King 3:6-28
- Children select the right answers to the activity questions

2) Discuss about Wise Choices

Photocopy and cut up page 149 (Wise Choices) from http://storage.cloversites.com/communitybiblechurch4/documents/016SU12%20HOBC%20G12 %20LG%20L12web.pdf

Instructions:

- Let kids pick a card each time and ask them to choose what they would do in each situation
- Ask: Was your choice easy to make? (e.g.yes, because only one choice seemed smart; because some of the choices were unkind)
- Ask: How do you feel when you had a hard choice to make? (e.g. frustrated, angry, don't want to choose)
- Ask: When have you asked someone for help in making a decision? (Once I asked my
 dad to help me decide what to do when my friend wanted me to do something wrong; I
 asked my sister if she thought Mom would get mad if I went to my friend's house to play.)
- Think of an important decision you made in the past couple of weeks. How did you decide what to do? (I asked my parents for help; I prayed.)
- Say: Everyone has to make important decisions at times. Sometimes choices are hard, and we need someone wiser to help us decide what to do. God helps us make wise choices. Also, we can follow our friend Jesus' example. Jesus had tough decisions to make when he lived on earth, and he always prayed to God to help him make wise choices. When we have tough decisions to make, we can do what Jesus did, and that's ask God for help. God will never let us down.

Craft Activity

Materials:

- 1) Photocopy page 150 (Hand It To God) from http://storage.cloversites.com/communitybiblechurch4/documents/016SU12%20HOBC%20G12%20LG%20L12web.pdf
- 2) Colouring pencils, markers
- 3) Paper glue

Instructions:

- Read Memory verse: "If any of you needs wisdom, you should ask God for it. He will give it to you. God gives freely to everyone and doesn't find fault." (James 1:5)
- Let children glue the cut-outs of the 2 hands
- Allow them to colour and decorate the card to their liking
- In the empty space on the card, ask the children to write a short prayer or draw a picture to describe the memory verse
