

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS: [The Barry J. White Memorial Award](#)

Barry J. White (1950-2011) was a member of the Turtle clan of the Seneca Nation and devoted many hours of service to his Native community—such as a board member for the Native American Community Services (NACS), the Seneca Nation Library Board of Trustees, and the Seneca-Iroquois National Museum Board. During his career, Barry contributed to several initiatives in Seneca language and culture preservation, as well as serving as a keynote speaker at various community events. Established in honor of Barry, who taught in the American Studies program at the University at Buffalo and who worked for the Center for the Development of Human Services of the S.U.N.Y. Research Foundation at Buffalo State for over 25 years, this award is given to an individual selected in recognition of exemplary service and/or contribution to Indian education at the higher education level.
