No Pattern to Buy.

Required: Bring a working Featherweight machine, walking foot, a new sharp microtext size 12 & 14 machine needle, binding clips, basic sewing supplies: scissors (both sewing and paper), snips, rotary cutter, ruler, thread, seam ripper, pen or marking pen/pencil/chalk, pins, ¼ inch foot or ¼ inch sewing options, optional travel iron and pad (wool mat is recommended), turning tool to smooth edges after turning. Don't forget featherweight oil.

You will need at least:

A half yard to a yard of 2 coordinating fabrics, one light and one dark and non-directional. The sample is using a 6" circle but you can use a bigger or smaller size. I will bring different sizes of circle tools and share different ways of cutting them out. If you have cereal box cardboard it can be handy to bring along.
