Your teachers will provide more information on your course final exam during the 4th QTR.

**All students are required to take a final exam for every course in which they are enrolled; this grade will constitute 10% of the final grade for the course. Final exams will be scheduled by individual teachers and will be administered during class time.**

**Regents exams will not be counted in students' final course averages. However, Regents exam scores will be included on students' transcripts and will determine students' graduation and diploma status. Any student who misses a Regents exam must make it up in August, or your Regents score will be posted as a "0" on your transcript.**

**The last day of classes for 9th, 10th & 11th grades is **Monday, June 8<sup>th</sup>**.**

## AP Exam Information

### Notes:

1. AP Exams are **required** for all 9th - 11th grade students enrolled in an AP course.
2. Due to the high volume of students in AP classes, St. Anthony's High School does not offer make-up exams unless a student has two AP Exams scheduled at the same date and time. The decision on which exam will be rescheduled is at the discretion of the St. Anthony's AP Coordinator.
3. Avoid scheduling trips, appointments, or other commitments during AP testing in May. ***This includes May 14 and May 15, 2026.***
4. Students **MUST** have their ID as they will be **REQUIRED** to scan into exams.
5. Students **MUST** arrive with a fully charged iPad. Be sure to test it for readiness in the Bluebook Exams app. No devices will be available to loan to students. Personal portable chargers are allowed.
6. Students are responsible to read and adhere to, "what you should" and "should not" bring to the exam which will be provided, along with room assignment locations on a future date. Mrs. Adler will be providing this information to AP Teachers and they will be posting in their Google Classrooms. Information will be posted in the library as well.
7. **Attire:** Students should wear Friday Friar Attire.
8. Students *testing with accommodations* will be sent a direct email on a future date with their reporting times/instructions.
9. Students with an AP Exam will be excused from classes the day of their exam(s). Students taking an exam may arrive by the reporting time and leave school when the exam concludes.
10. Other than the approved items, students will **not be allowed** to bring food, drink, string bags, backpacks into the exam rooms. **Please use lockers, cars or leave these items at home.**  
*NOTE: ANYONE with approved accommodations for specific items, may bring these items to their test. This will only be accepted in rooms designated for accommodation testing unless previously arranged with Mrs. Adler.*
11. **All students should make sure to know their College Board Login and Password *prior* to the exam.** Make sure to test it in advance of the test to ensure a smooth test-taking experience.
12. It is essential that all students be at exam location ***at or before the designated time*** to get pre-admin and tests to start on time. Since these tests are all Digital or Hybrid students must plan accordingly. **Students arriving more than 15 minutes late, after the official start times, may be denied testing that day as there will not be a proctor available for late arrivals.**
