II. Program Discussion (20 min)

- Recent/ongoing PTA event/program debriefs (5 min)
 - o Picture Day, Sciencenter, Enrichment, Gimme!, Refrigerator, Annual Fund

Maureen updates:

- Picture day was a success! On schedule (thanks to JoAnn!) and thanks to the volunteers who helped to make it all run smoothly
- Sciencenter Family night: 212 people attended; 100 adults and 112 kids. This was the largest group they've seen come in!
- Gimme Coffee sale: Katie Walsh is running it and is doing a great job! Over \$1k raised. Sarah adds that Katie reported there was great documentation
- Refrigerator: it has been delivered and installed, thanks to the vote from last month.

 Ready to be filled with healthy snacks. Ms. Uy updates that her class families are taking advantage of it!
- Newsletter went out, and updated formatting. Feel free to share any suggestions, or if you want to add anything, let her know.

Heather updates:

- Fall enrichment: 12 different enrichment classes going every week; 90+ kids are participating (some of which are in more than 1 class)

- Appreciate all of the support of teachers and staff who help kids get where they need to be; and the folks who have volunteered to help (Jessica, Christina as point people)
 - Upcoming events/programs/fundraisers
 - Snack Cabinet, Essentials Closet, Elves/Angels
 - Roller Skating Night, CHES Loves Snow, Basketball, Ski Club
 - o Fundraising and Bylaws committees, shared calendar
 - o Halloween
 - Ways to get involved!
 - Brainstorming w/ CHES community expertise and connections

Maureen moves on to upcoming events:

- Snack Cabinet: passes it over to JoAnn and Christina. Hoping to organize snacks in a cabinet that JoAnn is emptying out, so that anytime a teacher needs snacks, they can use it. They will set up an Amazon account and Instacart that JoAnn will organize so that you can order from there. Hoping that a parent might be willing to jump in and help to keep the wishlist up to date (and perhaps some periodic links).
 - Aileen mentions that the PTA opened up to have a budget line for the front office, and most of that goes to purchasing snacks.
 - Maureen mentions that there will be a google doc. And Christina adds there will also be a button to donate \$ towards snacks.
 - Katie is excited about this! She's been working with the food service director and wondering if there will be any cooperation with the food service teams.
 - *Christina F asked in the chat about food allergy friendly options.*
 - [Some more discussion about working with food services making fruit available etc. State food aid is contingent on a full meal. Christina will follow up.]
 - Katie asks about breakfast in the classroom. And Aileen speaks to some of the challenges of this (timing, food quality, cleanup). Katie asks about pre-k and Aileen says they have a different model/funding.
 - Maureen wraps up that clearly nutrition/food is something people feel strongly about, and this will be a longer-term conversation. If people want a sub-committee, let her know!
- Essentials closet: we can start supplying that, Aileen has said there is room. We are looking into getting some donations (e.g. Mark Wells suggested contacting REI). So encourage everyone to think about who they know in the community who could help.
 - Toiletries (comb, toothbrush + toothpaste, deodorant, sanitary products)
 - Clothes (pants, shirts, socks, underwear)
 - Outerwear (gloves, hats, jackets, belts)
 - Jamol suggests this could be added to an Amazon wishlist.

- Liz also mentions that PTAs can partner with Walmart to get these types of items.
- Elves/Angels: still hoping to get this to happen
 - [Sorry limited notes as my kid was getting dropped off at this time!]
- Roller Skating night: need a volunteer!
- CHES Loves Snow:
 - Nora Burrows is running it again (she's on top of it! Flyers already went home)
 - But her youngest is in 5th grade need a volunteer to shadow her so you can run it next year.

- Basketball

- Drew Margolin has been running the CHES basketball program for the last few years
- The forms digital and paper will be going out soon. The fees will be going up \$5 due to youth bureau costs. But still a pay as you can model.
- Looking for a 3rd grade boys coach.
- Looking to start practice on November 18th.

- Emails have started to go out. We have reserved the bus it's happening!
- It's on Wednesdays

- Director/Producer is Ms. Uy this year!
- Ms. Uy introduces herself: ran the drama program for middle school for a number of years. She's so excited to do it but needs a team of other adults to support it.

- We will do in-school dress rehearsals. There are auditions but everyone gets in just a chance to run it.
- Volunteers will be needed in-school as well as after school.
