1. Introduction of BarkinCraft

• Overview of BarkinCraft platform

Barkincraft is a Pentagon Games Exclusive Experience built by Versadia Studios. By combining their monster IP with Minecraft, Barkincraft aims to create a dynamic ecosystem where players can engage in games, explore diverse environments, capture various mons, and earn Bark tokens.

Barkincraft includes several unique games:

1. Battle Vault:

This is one of the most popular game modes currently in Minecraft. It is inspired by the Hypixel server, which has a daily active user base of around 50,000 players. This mode aims to destroy the beds in the enemy's bases by building bridges and using various weapons, including special ones specifically created for the Pentagon game experience. Pentagon Games has designed custom maps, a tribute to YGG, a Pentagon Games VC.

2. Meadows Quest:

This game mode allows players to explore various locations, capture different Barkmons, and engage in battles against other players. The game includes numerous places to visit, and more will be added in the future.

3. Line City Adventures:

This is a unique game mode that is available only on Barkincraft. It is inspired by the concept of a city being built in Saudi Arabia called "The Line." Within this mode, there are 800 unique residences where players can PLAY EARN OWN, live and furnish their apartments as they like. Players can also visit various locations within the city, shop, and take on different jobs, such as becoming a miner, gym trainer, or doctor, allowing them to earn tokens.

Barkincraft is a diverse and immersive gaming experience that combines elements of exploration, collection, combat, and role-playing within a unique Minecraft-based world.

2. How to get started: Create an account and basic navigation

Visit our website at "barkincraft.com," click "Launcher," and download the installer. Run the setup and follow the installation guide. Once installed, open it and log into your Pentagon Games account with the "Login" button.

3.1. BedWars Guide

• BedWars 101: A Beginner's Guide—Gameplay Mechanics

- **Objective:** The main goal in BedWars is to protect your bed while trying to destroy the beds of other teams. If your bed is intact, you can keep respawning after you die. However, once your bed is destroyed, you can no longer respawn; if you die after that, you're out of the game.
- Teams: Players are divided into teams, each starting on their island where their bed is.
- **Resources:** Each island generates resources like iron, gold, and diamonds. These resources can be used to buy your team's blocks, weapons, armor, and upgrades.
- **Strategy:** Players must balance gathering resources, defending their beds, and attacking other teams' beds. Each team must work together to protect their bed while also trying to eliminate opponents by destroying their beds.
- **Winning:** The game ends when all other teams have been eliminated (i.e., their beds have been destroyed and all team members have been killed).

Getting Start

How to enter Bedwars:

After joining the server, you'll be in the main lobby. Look for the BedWars NPCs and right-click on them, select the map you prefer, and enjoy the game.

- Basic Controls & User Interface

Movement:

- W Move forward
- S Move backward
- A Move left (strafe)
- **D** Move right (strafe)
- Spacebar Jump
- Shift (Left Shift) Sneak (prevents you from falling off edges and hides your nameplate from other players)

Camera and Interaction:

- Mouse Movement Look around/change camera direction
- Left Mouse Button Attack or break blocks
- Right Mouse Button Use item/place block
- Scroll Wheel Select items on the Hotbar

Inventory and Crafting:

- E Open the inventory. You can view items, move them around, and access your crafting grid.
- Shift + Click Quickly move items between the inventory and other containers (e.g., chests).

User Interface (UI)

Heads-Up Display (HUD):

- **Hotbar:** The row of slots at the bottom of the screen where you keep quick-access items. You can cycle through these with the number keys (1-9) or the mouse scroll wheel.
- Health Bar: Red hearts that indicate your health level. If they drop to zero, your character dies.
- Hunger Bar: Drumsticks or haunches indicating your hunger level. When it drops, your health won't regenerate, and when it's low, you can't sprint.
- Experience Bar: The green bar above the hotbar, showing your experience points (XP). These are used for enchanting items.
- Crosshair: The small "+" in the center of the screen helps you aim at blocks and entities.
- **Armor Bar**: The icons above your health bar indicate how much protection your armor provides.

Inventory Screen (E):

- Crafting Grid: A 2x2 grid for basic crafting. If you have a crafting table, it opens a 3x3 grid.
- Player Model: Shows your character and equipped armor.
- Hotbar and Inventory Slots: Where you manage your items.
- **Recipe Book:** On the left, it shows available crafting recipes.

Chat and Commands (T):

• Chat Window: Displays messages from other players and system notifications.

Specific to BedWars

Team/Bed Status:

- On the right side of the screen, you'll see a scoreboard showing:
 - **Teams:** Each team's color and bed status (intact or destroyed).
 - o **Players:** Number of players left on each team.

Resource Generators:

• Iron, Gold, Diamonds, Emeralds: These resources spawn on specific blocks and are crucial for buying items. The number of resources you're holding will appear in your hotbar.

Shop Interface:

- **Item Shop:** Right-click the shop NPC on your island to open the shop menu. Here, you can use resources to buy blocks, weapons, armor, tools, and special items.
- **Team Upgrades:** Right-click the "Team Upgrades" NPC to access team-wide upgrades like improved forge speed, stronger armor, or traps.

Player Stats:

• Above your hotbar, you may see important status effects, like when you're under the influence of a potion (e.g., speed or invisibility).

• Strategies and Tips

1. Defense Strategies

• Cover Your Bed Early:

 When the match starts, use your initial resources (iron and gold) to cover your bed with basic blocks like wool. This will give you some initial protection and buy time for more advanced defenses.

• Layered Defense:

Use multiple layers of different materials (e.g., wool, wood, endstone, obsidian)
 to make it harder for enemies to break through to your bed. Each material
 requires various tools to break quickly, which slows down attackers.

Trap Usage:

 Purchase traps from the "Team Upgrades" menu. Traps like "It's a Trap!" (which blinds and slows down enemies) or "Alarm Trap" (which reveals invisible players) can give you an advantage when enemies approach your base.

• Block Placement:

Place blocks around your base strategically to create obstacles. For example,
 place blocks in a checkerboard pattern to force enemies to waste time breaking
 more blocks or jumping around.

2. Resource Management

Prioritize Early Upgrades:

 Upgrade your forge (resource generator) to produce more resources as soon as you gather them. This gives you a steady flow of materials without venturing out immediately.

• Control Diamond Generators:

 Diamonds are crucial for team upgrades. Control the nearest diamond generator by building bridges to it early and placing defensive structures around it.

• Emerald Domination:

 Once you feel confident with your defense, venture to the center of the map to collect emeralds. Emeralds can be used for powerful items like obsidian, diamond armor, and potions.

• Resource Sharing:

If you're playing in a team, communicate and share resources. For example, one
player can focus on gathering emeralds while another defends the bed or
upgrades the team.

3. Offensive Strategies

• Rush Tactics:

 If you're confident in your PvP skills, consider rushing a nearby team early in the game. If they haven't fortified their bed, you might be able to destroy it quickly before they can react.

Bridge Building:

Build bridges to other islands cautiously. Use shift to sneak and prevent falling.
 Consider building elevated bridges or ones with protective walls to avoid being easily knocked off.

• Diversion and Invisibility:

- Use an invisibility potion (purchased with emeralds) to sneak into an enemy base unnoticed. Pair this with a jump potion to make it harder for enemies to hit you.
- Sometimes, it helps to send one teammate as a diversion while another sneaks in to destroy the bed.

• Fireballs and TNT:

- Fireballs are great for knocking opponents off bridges or destroying their defenses from a distance.
- TNT is effective for blowing up blocks protecting beds. Drop it from above, as it deals significant area damage.

4. PvP Combat Tips

Use Knockback to Your Advantage:

 When fighting on bridges or near edges, try knocking your opponent into the void. The Knockback Stick is beneficial for this.

Bow and Arrow:

A bow can be a game-changer, allowing you to snipe opponents from a distance.
 It's beneficial for knocking opponents off bridges or weakening them before a melee fight.

• Armor and Weapons:

• Prioritize upgrading your armor and weapons as the game progresses. Even a minor upgrade can make a significant difference in close combat.

• Golden Apples:

• Always keep a few golden apples in your inventory. They give you regeneration and additional hearts, which can be crucial during or right after a fight.

5. General Tips

Map Awareness:

 Keep an eye on other teams and how many players they have left. Use the scoreboard to track which teams still have their beds intact and plan your strategy accordingly.

Communication (Team Play):

 If you're playing with friends or other teammates, communication is key. Use chat or voice communication to coordinate attacks, defense, and resource gathering.

Endgame Strategy:

 If the game reaches a point where beds are destroyed (either by the timer or by opponents), switch your focus to survival. Stay geared up, avoid unnecessary risks, and pick your battles wisely.

Know When to Retreat:

 Sometimes, retreating is the best option. If you're outnumbered or outmatched, it's better to fall back, regroup, and come back stronger.

6. Advanced Tactics

Speed Bridging:

 Learn and practice speed bridging techniques to build bridges faster. This can give you a significant advantage when controlling key areas like diamond or emerald generators.

Bed Fake-Out:

• Create decoy structures around your bed to mislead opponents, making them waste time breaking into the wrong area.

• Obsidian Bed Defense:

o If you collect enough emeralds, surround your bed with obsidian. It's the hardest block to break, giving you a significant defensive advantage.

Objective and Gameplay Mechanics

The primary goal in The Line is to select a profession from the available options: Explorer, Doctor, Banker, or Miner. Each job offers unique opportunities to earn \$YARN, the in-game token that functions as the town's currency.

By choosing a job that suits your interests or strategy, you can start accumulating \$YARN through various activities related to your profession. For instance, as an Explorer, you might discover hidden treasures or valuable resources; as a Doctor, you'll be able to provide medical services to other residents, earning tokens in return; as a Banker, you could manage and invest other players' funds for profit; and as a Miner, you would extract and trade valuable minerals.

Once you've earned enough \$YARN, you can purchase a house or customize your living space with furnishings. The game is designed to offer a growing economy where your earnings can be reinvested into improving your lifestyle. In the future, the town will introduce even more exciting ways to spend your \$YARN, such as buying vehicles like cars, motorcycles, and even helicopters. This will enhance your experience in The Line and allow for greater mobility and exploration of the town and its surroundings.

Combining career choice, economic management, and customization options provides a rich, immersive gameplay experience. It encourages players to think strategically about their role in the town's economy and how best to utilize their resources to create the life they envision in The Line.

Getting Start

-How to enter The Line

After joining the server, you'll be in the main lobby. Look for the Line NPCs and right-click on them, select the map you prefer, and enjoy the game.

- Choosing a job

You can select the job you prefer by going to the train station, which is also the spawn point in the game mode. In front of you, you will see an NPC that will allow you to select the job you prefer by right-clicking.

- Navigating the city:

In The Line, Warps are teleportation points that allow players to move between key areas of the city quickly. By using the command /warp (warpname), players can access locations like the bank, bridge, cave, gym, hospital, mall, park, stadium, and train station. Each Warp offers unique opportunities, such as managing finances, exploring, training, healing, shopping, relaxing, participating in competitions, or traveling. These Warps enhance the gameplay experience, making navigating and interacting with the surrounding environment easier.

In The Line, we have a fully functional soccer stadium, which you can access using the /warp Stadium command. Once you enter the stadium and step onto the field, you'll be prompted in the chat to choose between the red or blue team. After selecting your team, you'll be teleported to your half of the field, ready to start the match.

Tips and Game Mechanics:

- Left Click: Use this to kick the ball with extra power, perfect for long shots or powerful passes.
- Double SPACE: Pressing the SPACE key twice consecutively gives you a boost that lets you jump much farther forward, ideal for quickly reaching the ball or outmaneuvering opponents.

Mazes:

In addition to the soccer stadium, The Line features seven different mazes, each with varying levels of complexity. To teleport to any of these mazes, you can use the commands /warp maze1 through /warp maze7. At the end of each maze, you'll find a chest containing a Nether Star. If you're the first to complete the maze and claim the Nether Star, you'll be rewarded with \$BARK tokens, adding a competitive edge to the challenge.

How to Earn Yarn Tokens and Bark Tokens in Barkincraft

-How to Earn Yarn Tokens:

Off-Chain Currency: Yarn Tokens are an off-chain currency within Barkincraft.

- Players can earn Yarn Tokens by participating in various in-game jobs. The amount earned varies depending on the specific job and level of engagement.
- Yarn Tokens earned in the game can be traded for BARK Tokens via Peer 2 Peer marketplace where user can bid or sell BARK to / from Yarn
 - BARK Tokens

On-Chain Currency: BARK Tokens serve as the on-chain currency in Barkincraft.

-How to Earn BARK Tokens:

- BARK token can be bought and sold via SwapFive.com on the Pentagon Chain (all testnet token will be replaced 1:1 when mainnet arrives)
- Converting Yarn Tokens: Yarn Tokens earned in the game can be exchanged with peers for for BARK Tokens
- Gameplay: Participate in various game modes such as Bed Wars to compete and earn Bark Tokens. Explore within The Line City for special loots to earn BARK. Catch mons and complete different objectives in the Barkmons game mode to earn BARK Tokens.

• Community Engagement: Actively participate in chat discussions and other community activities. (BARK are used as rewards, though buy back from core team)

What can you do with BARK TOKEN?

Purchase license right NFT, and various Assets in the various Barkindle & Friend franchise of games.
