Teaching Style:

My goal is that every child feels comfortable and valued in the classroom. I stress that everyone is treated with kindness and respect. We do a great deal of cooperative learning activities that enable us to deal with individual differences.

We will use a reading program called My View and a phonics program called Phonics to Reading. This will be our third year using these highly-reputable programs. Students will learn reading, writing, spelling, and vocabulary using multiple learning styles. This program also uses technology so your child will be able to learn Language Arts using the Flat Panel, chromebooks, and hands-on activities! Math will be taught through a series called enVision Mathematics. This program is a problem-solving based approach which allows children to practice skills in a variety of ways.

Schedule:

On the back of this handout you will see our daily schedule. Please note this may change slightly- a finalized daily schedule will be sent home within the first few weeks of school. These special classes will be held as follows and will not change:

PE: Day 2, 4 and 6 Library: Day 3 and 5

Your child will need gym shoes for PE. I highly suggest students keep a pair at school.
