STRONGSVILLE HIGH SCHOOL FALL SPECTATOR & TICKETING GUIDELINES

Ticketing Information

- Strongsville High School will be utilizing Ticket Spicket for its online ticketing system for the 2020-2021 seasons. All tickets will be digital and will be contactless. Click [HERE](#) for the link. When you arrive at the link, please type in Strongsville for Strongsville High School to appear. All Events for the day/week will be posted there. Click on the event for which you want to purchase tickets. All programs/athletes will be given a code to purchase the tickets. When you use your email to purchase the tickets with the code, the system will only allow you to purchase 4 tickets (*to comply with the OHSA and ODH guidelines on spectators*). If you have any technical issues, please contact the athletic office and we will walk you through the process. More information will be given out to individual teams and programs prior to their first home game with their unique codes. Varsity Football:

- All tickets for varsity football will be sold by the participating schools in a pre-sale format (there will be no sale of tickets at gates for varsity football)
- All HOME TEAM fans should enter the stadium parking lot from LUNN Road. Only those spectators with purchased tickets will be allowed to enter. All visiting team spectators should enter from Pearl Road and turn onto Rademaker Drive. (By the SCS Bus Garage)
- All tickets will be sold at the general admission price of \$7.
- **ALL FANS MUST WEAR MASKS IN THE VENUE THE ENTIRE TIME. NO EXCEPTIONS**
- **All home games will be live streamed via BOXCAST for viewing at home**
- **If you DO NOT have a ticket, you will NOT be allowed on the premise to watch the game from outside the stadium**
- There will be **NO CONCESSIONS SOLD AT FOOTBALL GAMES**. We have worked with many local businesses that on Friday nights they will welcome visitors with possible discounts and portions of sales will be going back to the District.
- The home school will allocate four (4) tickets for every varsity football player (maximum 60) & coaches, every varsity cheerleader & coach, and every marching band member & director. Seating pods will be marked off in groups of 4. If an athlete only uses 2 tickets and wants to assign other 2 allocated tickets to friends or relatives, that is fine, but those people **MUST SIT IN THE SAME POD AS THE OTHER TWO TICKETS**. We will be blocking off other seats where people CANNOT SIT to be in compliance with Social Distancing.

- The visiting school will be allocated a minimum of two-hundred (200) tickets to be sold to immediate family members of varsity football players (maximum 60) & coaches and varsity cheerleaders and coaches (**Note: marching bands will not be traveling to away contests**).
 - Some member school's facilities will allow for the visiting allocation to be slightly higher (the visiting school will determine how to appropriately allocate the extra tickets amongst their players for immediate family).

Junior Varsity & Freshman Football:

- School's are encouraged to offer pre-sale options if available.
- Fans are encouraged to utilize pre-sale options when available.
- Gate sales will only be available to family members of players participating who have been allocated tickets.
- **ALL FANS MUST WEAR MASKS IN THE VENUE THE ENTIRE TIME. NO EXCEPTIONS**
- **All home games will be live streamed via BOXCAST for viewing at home**
- **If you DO NOT have a ticket, you will NOT be allowed on the premise to watch the game from outside the stadium**
- There will be **NO CONCESSIONS SOLD**
- The home school will allocate four (4) tickets for every JV or Freshman football player (maximum 60 on the roster) & coach, every varsity cheerleader & coach. Seating pods will be marked off in groups of 4. If an athlete only uses 2 tickets and wants to assign other 2 allocated tickets to friends or relatives, that is fine, but those people **MUST SIT IN THE SAME POD AS THE OTHER TWO TICKETS**. We will be blocking off other seats where people CANNOT SIT to be in compliance with Social Distancing.

Soccer:

- School's are encouraged to offer pre-sale options if available (home and away games).
- Fans are encouraged to utilize pre-sale options when available.
- Gate sales will only be available to family members of players participating who have been allocated tickets (whether provided a code by the home school or indicated on a roster by the athletic department).
- The home school will allocate four (4) tickets for every athlete & coach, and every JVA or JVB player per their individual games. (i.e. if a JVA or JVB player is playing at 5pm, they will be allocated a number of tickets for their game only. As of right now, they will **NOT** be permitted to stay for the varsity game as we try to keep the attendance to a minimum)
- The visiting school will allocate four (4) tickets for every Varsity, JVA or JVB player & coach. If JVA or JVB players are riding the visiting team bus back to their respective schools,
- At Foltz, Seating pods will be marked off in boxes for groups of 4. All spectators should bring their own chair. The bleachers will be blocked off. If an athlete only uses 2 tickets and wants to assign other 2 allocated tickets to friends or relatives, that is fine, but those people **MUST SIT IN THE SAME POD AS THE OTHER TWO TICKETS**. We will be blocking off other seats where people CANNOT SIT. The BOXES marked off are 6 foot by 6 foot and are 6 feet apart (35 boxes on the Home side and 16 boxes on the visiting side). Every fan in attendance must be sitting in a box.
- **MASKS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHEN ENTERING THE SOCCER COMPLEX**
- **NO CONCESSIONS WILL BE SOLD AT SOCCER EVENTS**

- We ask that if you are coming for the varsity game, that you do not arrive prior to 6:30.
- After the JV game on Field 8 at Foltz, all athletes and spectators will be asked to leave via the East side of the complex. They will NOT BE PERMITTED to watch the Varsity game unless you have a child/sibling participating in the game.

Volleyball:

- School's are encouraged to offer pre-sale options if available.
- Fans are encouraged to utilize pre-sale options when available.
- **MASKS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIME INSIDE THE GYMNASIUMS**
- Gate sales will only be available to family members of players participating who have been allocated tickets (whether provided a code by the home school or indicated on a roster by the athletic department).
- The Freshman Volleyball games will be held in the Back Gym or Gym #3 and will begin at 4:30PM. JV games will be held in the main gym and start at 5:00pm. Varsity will begin at 6:30PM or 15 minutes after the JV game ends. We are asking that all Freshman athletes and parents exit the back gym out the Athletic Doors (doors closest to the gym by the training room) after their match is over. After the JV match is over, we are asking JV parents and athletes to exit through the Back Doors by the Athletic Office. Athletes may exit through the middle gym and then out the back athletic doors. NO FRESHMAN or JV Athlete will be permitted to stay and watch the Varsity game unless they are a parent or sibling of a Varsity athlete.
- Seating in the Main Gym will only be allowed in the Balcony area on both sides. Handicapped seating will be available on the lower level if needed.
- Seating pods are recommended within the bleachers. 4 seats in a pod and every other row will be blocked off. Tape will be used to mark which seats are available and which seats are not
- We will have the HUDL camera available to film. We are working on getting the JV and Varsity games live streamed with our youtube channel, but games will also sync up with our new scorevision fanapp which will give real time updates with scores.
- The home school will allocate four (4) tickets for every Varsity, JV or freshman athlete (maximum 15) & coach.
- The visiting school will allocate four (4) tickets for every Varsity, JV or freshman athlete (maximum 15) & coach
- **NO CONCESSIONS WILL BE SOLD DURING HOME MATCHES**
- **NO INVITES, TOURNAMENTS, TRI'S or QUADS ARE ALLOWED PER THE NEW HEALTH ORDER**

Greater Cleveland Conference Passes:

- As member schools of the GCC, each school is allocated an equal number of conference passes to be used at the discretion of the individual schools. Schools are asked to carefully distribute these given current spectator limitations (Note: a maximum of twenty-five (25) GCC passes will be accepted)
- The GCC pass will be the pass used to allow admittance to the sideline of any soccer or football game. Any individual who does not have a GCC pass, will not be permitted access to the sideline at these events (Note: players, coaches, team personnel, medical staff, home school personnel, game workers, and credentialed media are the only

individuals other than those with a GCC pass that should be on the sideline of any event. Home schools are asked to clearly identify non uniformed game workers/personnel).

- GCC passes admit one (1) individual.
- **GCC passes are not to be distributed to students.**

Senior Citizen Admission:

- Due to the unique and challenging requirements sites face in managing spectator capacity, the GCC will not be able to offer free admission to senior citizens during the 2020 fall seasons, ***however senior citizens (65+) who are part of players family may purchase a ticket at the student rate or \$5 Varsity/JV events & \$2 Freshman, Middle School (JV stand alone) events (Note: all tickets for varsity football are \$7).***

Faculty & Student Passes:

- Due to the unique and challenging requirements sites face in managing spectator capacity, the GCC will not be able to honor faculty passes or student passes during the 2020 fall seasons.

Live Streaming Options:

- In light of the spectator restrictions, many schools have partnered with live streaming suppliers so fans who may not have the ability to attend in person, may still have the ability to watch online. Please contact your individual schools athletic department for information on potential live streaming options for your school.
