Course structure

To fulfil the requirements of the Bachelor of Arts and Social Sciences, students must complete the following:

- 1) Arts and Social Sciences specified study including an Arts minor and Arts electives (48 credit points)
- 2) Arts and Social Sciences listed major (48 credit points)
- 3) Free electives (48 credit points) Students may take a maximum of eight non-Arts units (e.g. Business, Science). For students who wish to complete a second major in the Business area of study, please ensure that you carefully check the unit requirements listed on the School of Business website. Please note that the school is not responsible if a student fails to comply with the unit requirements.

Additional requirement:

General Studies (categories U1, U2, U3 and U4) are also part of the graduation requirement. Please complete the general studies requirement to ensure your course completion process and duration. Please refer to the General Studies website for more details.

Note:

You **must** complete units as specified in the course structure Parts 1, 2 and 3 (144 points): a minimum of 96 points of Arts and Social Sciences listed study over Parts 1 and 2, and 48 points of free electives in Part 3.

Students **must** not complete more than 10 units (60 credit points) at the first-year level.

Students **must** complete a minimum of 36 credit points at the third-year level.

Other requirements:

- For any area of study managed by the Faculty of Arts, students who have successfully completed a unit are not permitted to re-enrol in the same unit for the purpose of improving their mark or grade.
- Students intending to pursue Honours studies must have completed a major in the intended discipline, including a minimum of 24 credit points at Level 3, to be eligible.
