The overwhelming support of parishioners continues to make the Memorial Garden a successful project. The garden is being maintained and managed by a small team of parish volunteers, who provide some comfort to parishioners who have lost a member of their family. The garden provides a modest income to the parish, but it provides much more to the Parish and Parishioners. It is a beautiful area beside our beautiful church, where parishioners visit and pray for friends and relatives. It provides great comfort to parishioners to have a garden devoted to those who have returned home to God.

In view of the continued support of parishioners, the St John Bosco and St Mary Mazzarello walls were almost fully reserved by the beginning of 2016. So two new walls were added in July 2016. The St Francis de Sales and St Mary of the Cross MacKillop walls were installed in July 2016. These have also proven very popular with only 35 of the 67 niches in the St Mary MacKillop wall remaining available.
