4.3 – 4.7 Roles in Development - Opinion Report

Overview:

This project is meant to give you an opportunity to use the research you recently did on a less developed country and now, and more importantly, evaluate its best options for growth and development.

Assignment:

1. Go back to the data/indicators you gathered for your recent Infographics project. USE it to do the following...
2. Imagine you are a Chicago School of Economics PhD and you've been hired by that country's government to advise them on what they should do to increase their country's growth and development. Narrow the list of strategies (roles of domestic and foreign sectors) we studied down to the THREE you think will be most effective in helping this country. Write a report to the country's government including the following for EACH role/strategy:
 - a. The name of the role/strategy
 - b. An explanation of the role/strategy
 - c. What you think the result of the role/strategy will be when implemented
 - d. Why you chose that role/strategy over others (why this one is better)**Note:** c. and/or d. must relate to the *data (indicators)* you found in your research
3. You will make a visual presentation (ppt, prez, google presentation, imovie, or whatever format you choose) You will have NO citations nor a bibliography! This is an opinion presentation on data you've already sourced.
