1. Acceptance of These Terms

These Terms of Service ("Terms") govern access to and use of The DevSec Blueprint website, Discord community, learning materials, memberships, programs, applications, events, and related services (collectively, the "Services"). The Services are operated by The DevSec Blueprint LLC ("DSB," "we," "us," or "our").

By creating an account, connecting a Discord account, purchasing or using a membership, participating in a DSB program, or otherwise accessing the Services, you agree to these Terms and the policies incorporated by reference, including the Privacy Policy, Refund Policy, Community Guidelines, Code of Conduct, and Content Sharing & Intellectual Property Policy.

2. Eligibility and Accounts

- You must provide accurate information, maintain the security of your account, and promptly update material changes.
- You are responsible for activity conducted through your DSB account and connected Discord account.
- You may not create accounts for another person, transfer access, share credentials, or use another member's access without permission.
- You must be at least 18 years old or have the legal capacity required to enter into these Terms in your location. DSB is not directed to children under 13.

3. Builder Membership and Access

DSB currently offers the Builder membership. Builder is a paid annual membership that provides the learning, community, project, group-programming, and other features described on the applicable membership or checkout page. DSB may introduce, modify, or discontinue offerings in the future, but no other membership tier is offered under these Terms unless DSB expressly publishes it.

- **Builder access is personal, non-transferable, revocable, and limited to the term and scope stated at purchase.**
- **Builder features, resources, programming, and benefits are limited to those published by DSB and may be updated as permitted by these Terms.**
- **Promotional, complimentary, or otherwise granted Builder access may be subject to different durations, eligibility requirements, or restrictions communicated by DSB.**
- **Access to specific events, sessions, reviews, releases, or community areas may be subject to scheduling, capacity, participation, conduct, or eligibility requirements.**

4. Billing, Renewal, and Cancellation

The Builder membership is billed monthly unless the applicable checkout page states otherwise. Prices, taxes, and included features are disclosed at or before purchase. Where auto-renewal is offered and you opt into it, you authorize DSB and its payment processor to charge the applicable renewal amount using your selected payment method until you cancel.



You may disable auto-renewal through the available billing portal or other method provided by DSB. Disabling auto-renewal prevents a future renewal charge; it does not end access before the current paid term expires. You remain responsible for charges incurred before cancellation takes effect. Refund eligibility is governed by the DSB Refund Policy in effect at the time of purchase.

Payment processing is provided by Stripe or another disclosed payment processor. DSB does not store full payment-card numbers.

5. No Guaranteed Outcomes

DSB provides educational resources, community access, group programming, project guidance, and review within the published scope of an offering. DSB does not guarantee employment, interviews, promotions, salary increases, certification exam results, project completion, technical mastery, response times, community participation, or any particular career, financial, or business outcome.

6. Support and Founder Capacity

Support is limited to the published scope of the Builder membership. Discord access does not create unlimited access to the founder, employees, contractors, contributors, or community leaders and does not include private consulting, individualized debugging, private code review, or a guaranteed response time unless expressly stated. DSB may cap enrollment or attendance, reschedule or cancel group sessions, modify programming, or limit support when reasonably necessary to protect quality, safety, availability, or operating capacity.

7. Programs, Project Reviews, and Certificates

DSB programs, project reviews, events, and group learning activities are educational in nature. They are not private coaching or consulting unless expressly identified as such, and they are not accredited academic programs, professional licenses, vendor certifications, or job-placement services.

Where DSB offers a Certificate of Completion or other recognition, it is earned only after the member satisfies the applicable published requirements. Recognition confirms completion of the identified DSB requirements and does not represent licensure, vendor certification, employment qualification, or mastery beyond the scope actually reviewed.

8. Community Conduct

You must comply with DSB's Community Guidelines and Code of Conduct. You may not harass, threaten, discriminate against, exploit, impersonate, spam, scam, distribute malware, misuse another person's information, circumvent access controls, or disrupt the community or Services.

DSB may warn, moderate, suspend, restrict, remove, or terminate access for conduct that violates these Terms or community standards, creates risk to others, interferes with the Services, harms the learning environment, or exposes DSB to legal, security, operational, or reputational harm.



9. Intellectual Property and License

Except for public materials expressly identified under an applicable open-source or other public license, the Services and DSB materials—including paid walkthroughs, instructional prose, templates, videos, recordings, private community materials, project rubrics, review materials, trademarks, branding, and documentation—are owned by or licensed to DSB and are protected by applicable intellectual-property laws.

Subject to these Terms and an active entitlement, DSB grants you a limited, personal, non-exclusive, non-transferable, revocable license to access and use applicable materials for your own learning and implementation. You may apply the knowledge and skills you learn to your own independently created work, but you may not reproduce, redistribute, resell, publish, scrape, mirror, sublicense, or create substitute or derivative courseware from protected DSB materials except where DSB expressly permits it in writing.

10. Open Source

Public DSB repositories and other expressly identified open-source materials are governed by their respective licenses. These Terms do not replace, expand, or restrict rights granted by an applicable repository or open-source license. Paid guidance, walkthrough prose, private materials, videos, templates, member discussions, and other restricted content are not automatically open source merely because related source code or a related repository is public.

11. Third-Party Services

The Services may integrate with or link to third-party services, including Stripe, Discord, GitHub, Google, and hosting, authentication, communications, or analytics providers. Your use of those services may be subject to separate terms and privacy policies. DSB does not control those services and is not responsible for their independent terms, practices, availability, security, or content.

12. Disclaimers and Limitation of Liability

To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Services are provided "as is" and "as available" without warranties of any kind, whether express, implied, or statutory, including warranties of merchantability, fitness for a particular purpose, title, and non-infringement. DSB does not warrant that the Services will be uninterrupted, error-free, completely secure, or suitable for every environment or use case.

To the fullest extent permitted by law, DSB and its owners, employees, contractors, contributors, and service providers will not be liable for indirect, incidental, special, consequential, exemplary, or punitive damages, or for lost profits, revenue, data, goodwill, opportunities, or business interruption arising from or related to the Services. Where liability cannot be excluded, DSB's aggregate liability will not exceed the amount you paid to DSB for the applicable paid offering during the 12 months preceding the event giving rise to the claim.



13. Indemnity

To the fullest extent permitted by law, you agree to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless DSB and its owners, employees, contractors, contributors, and service providers from claims, losses, liabilities, damages, judgments, and reasonable expenses arising from your misuse of the Services, violation of these Terms, infringement or violation of another person's rights, content or materials you submit, or unlawful conduct.

14. Changes, Suspension, and Termination

DSB may update these Terms, modify or discontinue features or offerings, or suspend or terminate access when reasonably necessary. Material changes will be posted with an updated effective date or otherwise communicated as required by law. Continued use of the Services after updated Terms become effective constitutes acceptance of those Terms to the extent permitted by law. Provisions that by their nature should survive termination—including intellectual-property, disclaimers, limitation of liability, indemnity, and governing-law provisions—will survive.

15. Governing Law and Contact

These Terms are governed by the laws of the State of Texas, without regard to conflict-of-law rules, except where applicable law requires otherwise. Any dispute will be brought in a court of competent jurisdiction located in Texas unless applicable law requires a different forum.
