## Condition report

- Paper moderately smooth, medium weight, light cream color
- Musty smell
- Minor tear in book cloth at joint on lower third of front cover
- Slight wearing through of book cloth at head & tail of spine and at corners of front and back covers
- Headband cloth worn through across right two thirds of headband at head
- Headband cloth torn through with cord support coming through and hanging loose final two thirds of headband at tail
- Surface dirt across all of book cloth

- Break about half way across book cloth on spine
- Some staining on fore edge of text block
- Minor losses at edges of fly leaves, front and back
- Paste downs and fly leaves separated to expose mull, both front and back
- Some separation of spine lining tail end near front of book, visible from open front cover
- Under 2" tears at gutters of front fly leave and first two leaves of first signature
- Minor staining in margins and across some pages, occasional throughout
- Some detritus in gutters, occasional and throughout
- Spine breaks occasional throughout textblock
- Dog-eared corner pp 211 and nick in head pp41-48 in "Exhortations, Prayers and Hymns"; folded corners pp 5, 55-65 in "Daily Prayer Book for Women With Child, In Labour"
- Plates printed throughout book in good condition
- Inscription on second flyleaf in ink

### Treatment proposal

#### Required for basic stabilization

- Overall surface cleaning
- Non-invasive spine lining with tissue
- Tissue hinge repair to reattach separated pastedown and fly leaves (not toned)
- Tissue repair to reattach separated lower corner of first two leaves of first signature
- Unfold and iron dog-eared and nicked pages
- Reattach headband core for tail headband
- Readhere tear in joint book cloth on front cover
- 4-flap box to house book

## Approved treatment plan

- Clean surfaces
- Unfold dog eared pages
- Slip spine lining in between hollow and textblock spine
- Tissue v hinge on spine
- Toned tissue hinges for gutter of inner front covers
- Resecure headbands
- Repair tear in cloth of front cover joint
