PAPATOETOE WEST SCHOOL

Uniform Dress Code

RATIONALE

The Papatoetoe West School Uniform Rules promotes equitable learning outcomes for all students by equality of dress and fosters a sense of identity and pride in the school.

GOALS

- To promote school spirit
- To develop students' self image and self esteem
- To remove any unhealthy peer pressure
- To provide a cost effective alternative to mufti
- To promote safety
- To establish our place within the community as a school with high standards

DRESS CODE

- 1. The school has a uniform that every child is expected to wear correctly
 - School long or short sleeve polo shirt
 - Black track pants, shorts or skorts
 - School fleece jumper
 - School jacket (maroon)
 - Plain black lace up or velcro footwear or black school sandals
 (jandals, sandals without a back strap, or casual footwear like Crocs are not permitted).
 - Black or navy ankle socks
- 2. Every child is expected to abide by our school dress code which is as follows:
 - All uniform items should be named
 - Name tags must be worn
 - Small sleeper earrings or small studs are the only jewellery permitted (see note 3 below)
 - If students are not in the correct uniform they must provide a note/parent communication and a uniform pass is issued by the classroom teacher
 - Black tights (stockings) or leggings may be worn under track pants, shorts or skorts.
 - Black Kidscan jackets may be worn to and from school only
 - Dark coloured thermal tops may be worn under the school polo shirt in Winter.
 - Nail varnish is not to be worn
- 3. The Principal (or their delegate) may grant an exemption to the uniform or dress code. This will only be given for exceptional circumstances and only for a specified period of time. In some cases a cultural exemption may be considered. The appropriate staff will be informed of the time period. Exemptions will only be made by the sending of a written note to school signed by a parent or caregiver. The note must state the reason for the child's inability to either wear the uniform or for not abiding by the dress code.
- 4. The uniform and dress code will be stated in the school Information booklet.

 Children must be wearing our uniform before they will be admitted to a classroom. Uniforms are available from Angels Fashions 98 St George Street, Papatoetoe and NZ Uniforms from Unit 5, 20 Lambie Drive. Manukau.
- 5. Uniforms for sports teams/choir/band and so on are supplied by the school.
- 6. Sun hats are compulsory in terms one and four.
