In order to successfully graduate, students must:

- Earn a grade of a "C -" or better or Pass (P) in all courses
 - ART 115, ART 131, and ART 117 must be passed with a C- or higher; P not accepted
- Earn all required credits required for program
- Cumulative GPA must be at least 2.0
