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ATA – Trainer Role Descriptions Role Title: Mentor

- Qualified Mentors oversee the development and qualification of Trainers-in-Training as they progress through the Academy.
- Inspires, organizes, and leads meetings that involve all team members, problem-solving and resolving conflicts as needed.
- Support mentees in developing an <u>Individual Development Plan</u> and qualifying them as they
 successfully demonstrate their Roles & Responsibilities, Competencies, Content Credits and Bench
 Hours.
 - o Provides assignments to mentees to support completion of IDP goals.
 - o Assesses the effectiveness of the mentee's skills by observing the mentee in the Trainer role.
 - Provides feedback on performance and how well-prepared the mentee is in various skills and areas.
 - Using the IDP, creates a learning strategy to bridge the gap of the mentee's development.
 - Evaluates mentee's performance post completion of IDP and makes further recommendations.
- Establishes mentee programs and mentoring for Interns and Associate Trainers as required
- Oversees mentees and actively pursues opportunities to work with them throughout the delivery of the program.
- Promotes the development of others by providing opportunities for growth. Encourages the
 development of the mentee's own discernment and does not enable dependency.
- Knows when to step back and let others take charge.

KRI Requirements

- Be a Professional or a Lead Trainer
- Completion of Mentoring Development Program
- Fully Level Two certified.
- Abides by the KRI Code of Ethics and Professional Standards and represents the Golden Chain.
- Attends at least one major KRI, IKYTA or 3HO Event every year.
- Attends a Trainer Forum at least every other year.
- Continues to teach Kundalini Yoga classes.
- To continue developing the required Qualities of a Mentor (See the details on the required competencies in the document — MnT Competency Evaluation Form)
- Have a valid KRI Trainer License, renewed annually.
