I. Upcoming Activities for FY2015

FCC Form 486

After you go through PIA review and receive a Funding Commitment Decision Letter (FCDL) for each funding request, you will need to file a Form 486 with USAC to indicate the start of services. The Form 486 must be certified no later than 120 days after the service start date (likely July 1) or 120 days after the date of the FCDL, whichever is later.

BEARs

You cannot submit a BEAR for reimbursement until the Form 486 has been filed. The deadline to file a BEAR for FY2015 is October 28, 2016.

II. Continuing Activities for FY2014

FCC Form 486

If you still have an FY2014 Form 471 FRN that has not yet been issued a Funding Commitment Decision Letter, once you do receive an FCDL, you have 120 days from the date of that letter to certify a Form 486.

BEARS

You cannot submit a BEAR for reimbursement until the Form 486 has been filed, but the deadline to file a BEAR for FY2014 is October 28, 2015. Make sure you leave enough time for your service provider to certify the form.

Network Maine RFP for Internet for Schools and Libraries went out, vendors chosen. All but around 7 schools will be getting fiber connections of 100Mb/s or better. Installs are happening already, going throughout the summer, hopefully all will be done by the start of school.

Letter from Anne Davis dated May 6 went out to all Network Maine members regarding E-Rate audit findings. No specific news on possible findings regarding CIPA compliance in a small number of locations, but we wanted to make note of the letter. Also, this is a good time to review your E-Rate documentation, and remember that you need to keep documentation for 10 years now.
