Timberlake Earth Sanctuary

We will be gathering at the barn at [Timberlake North](#).
After you enter the Timberlake property:

- Stay left on the main road.
- Turn left at the bend, then drive downhill.
- The parking area is beside the barn.

Accommodations

The barn includes A/C and heat, a group kitchen, bathrooms, and a shower.

You're welcome to come for daytime only or stay overnight.

Options for overnight stays:

- Bring your own tent or hammock and camp under the stars.
 - Bring a mat and sleep upstairs in the shared indoor barn space (also our group meeting space).
 - For an added fee, stay in a canvas wall tent with cot and bedding: \$90 for two nights.
 - By request, a private bedroom is available if there is someone who needs special accommodations.

Schedule Overview

Day One:

- Arrive between 4–6pm to walk the land and settle in.
- Dinner served around 6pm
- Opening ceremony at 7:30pm including fire circle and ceremonial music.
(Optional: *Hapé ceremonial tobacco may be offered for those who feel called.*)

Days 2-3 (10am–4pm)

- Two days of guided group sessions, earth-based practices, rest, and reflection, fire circles, music, and emergent ceremony.
 - Saturday Dinner at 6pm, evening council around 7:30pm.
 - We'll clean up and close around 4pm Sunday.

- Dress for both outdoors and indoor time. Be prepared for heat, cold and rain.
 - Chair, mat or pillows for sitting comfortably outside
 - Journal (optional)
 - Bring your own lunches (see above)
 - Overnight gear and toiletries for those who are staying at night
 - Ceremonial elements to add to the group altar (optional)
 - Instruments such as rattles, guitars, drums (optional)
 - And most importantly:
Bring your questions and sacred songs.
Bring your sorrow, your story, your longing to belong.
Bring curiosity about your unique gifts and responsibilities to all of life.
