



Human Growth and Development Annual Notification

The Norris School District is in compliance with Wisconsin Statute 118.01, delivers a curriculum of protective behaviors, personal development, and lifelong health with the competency continuums in Academics, Employability, Citizenship, and Wellness serving as the framework. The following competency clusters (courses) contain competencies that could address protective behaviors, personal development, and lifelong health. Learners address the competencies in each cluster as part of their Personal Plan and Pathway.

No learner may be required to address the competencies pertaining to Human Growth and Development if the Parent/Guardian files a written request that the student be exempted. In such a case, an alternative competency(s) will be determined as a replacement for those exempted.
