

Plot Elements (STORY MOUNTAIN)

1. **Exposition** - Explaining the background of the story, which is introducing the characters (main character (s) and supporting ones), setting (where did the story take place in?), conflict (the problem in the story).
2. **Actions** - Describes and shows us the actions and parts that happen in the story which takes place before the rising action and climax starts. These are the parts that will build up the rising action.
3. **Rising Action** - The part that happens right before the climax happens. The rising action is what causes the climax to happen, is like a supporting part to the high point of a story.
4. **Climax** - This is the most important part that occurs in the story, this is the high point in the story where the most crazy and tragic thing happens that will change the whole story.
5. **Falling Action** - This is what happens near the end of the story (conclusion). This is where everyone in the story or the main characters will be tied up or resolved.
6. **Resolution/Conclusion** - The resolution or so called a conclusion is the last stage in the story mountain. This part concludes everything that had happened in the story, this is what happens at the end, normally comes with a theme.
