

Student Poster Competition

The 2025 Student Poster Competition is a part of our annual conference, which will be held October 16th-19th in St. Louis Missouri. The poster competition is ideal for undergraduate or graduate students looking to share their applied, clinical, or public sociology related research projects with a diverse community of sociology professionals. This is an opportunity to have dynamic and engaging conversations about your past or current sociological investigations and discoveries.

The submission deadline is July 1, 2025 for poster abstracts.

We welcome submissions that meet the following criteria:

1. Posters must contain original work or reflect a significantly revised version of a previously submitted poster;
2. Poster projects may be single-authored or co-authored with other students at the same level (undergraduate or graduate), not faculty;
3. Posters may be presented individually or as a team;
4. Projects may be at any stage of the research process; and,
5. Author(s) may submit only one poster.
6. Posters will be presented in one session (typically at the opening reception on Thursday evening) so you should expect to arrive at the conference by Thursday afternoon.
7. Posters should be formatted on a hard poster board surface - preferably a tri-folding presentation board. If you are not able to bring a tri-fold board to the conference, please contact student committee co-chair Jenny Chamberlain at jlchamberlain@southtexascollege.com to make other arrangements.

Winning posters will receive a cash prize that will be presented at the AACSB Business Meeting that closes the conference!
