Created in 2019 by Welsh-Australian dachshund enthusiast Jamie Robinson, World Dachshund Day is a global celebration of all things dachshund.

Held annually on the June solstice — the longest day of the year in the Northern Hemisphere and the shortest day in the Southern Hemisphere — World Dachshund Day brings together dachshunds and their humans to celebrate the breed, raise awareness of dachshund welfare and help preserve the future of dachshunds through education, responsible ownership and community connection.

Dachshund lovers and their dogs come together through walks, meet-ups and community events held globally, creating a shared celebration that follows the sun across different countries and time zones.

In addition to the unique level of fun that only a large gathering of dachshunds can provide, World Dachshund Day encourages owners and supporters to work together to help reduce the number of dachshunds requiring rehoming through education, advocacy and support for local rescue organisations.

Prospective owners are encouraged to attend local events to learn more about the breed and whether dachshund ownership is right for them.

Attendees are encouraged to make a donation to their local dachshund rescue or welfare organisation, helping support dachshunds in need within their local communities.

World Dachshund Day continues to grow through the passion of volunteers, rescue groups, ambassadors and dachshund enthusiasts around the globe.
