Board of Directors may serve up to three (3) elected three (3)-year terms. Only administrators, Superintendents, Assistant Superintendents, Principals or Assistant Principals are eligible to run or vote. **The Superintendent must designate a voting representative in writing.**

Candidates for a position on the AAA Board of Directors must notify the AAA office and their Activity District President at least two (2) weeks prior to the Activity District meeting where their election will be held of their intention to seek election. If a district has more than one board member each board member must be from a different classification.

Positions Open:

District 1W Position currently held by Dr. Jared Cleveland of Springdale. He has served his second three-year term. Dr. Cleveland is eligible for re-election and has declared for the position.

District 2 Position currently held by Dean Stanley of Searcy. Mr. Stanley is completing his first three-year term and retiring. An election will be held to fill the open position which is a three-year term.

District 3 Position currently held by Hugh Inman of Marion. Mr. Inman is completing his first three-year term and retiring. An election will be held to fill the open position which is a three-year term.

District 4 Position currently held by Trent Goff of Booneville. He has served his first three-year term. Mr. Goff is eligible for re-election and has declared for the position.

District 5 Position currently held by Shawn Halbrook of South Conway County. He has served his second three-year term. Mr. Halbrook is eligible for re-election and has declared for the position.
