II. Minutes Review and Approval

- d. Conference Meals Leslie Whalin said the SignUp Genius for donations went out at the beginning of the week. Breakfast will be provided on Saturday morning. She has planned a meal from Chipotle for Tuesday evening.
- e. Teacher Appreciation Leslie Whalin advised that the Committee was focused on Teacher Appreciation Week in early May and would have more info about this year's theme and plan after Spring Break.
