Market Awareness: Level 2-3, this market often knows about the bad taste, odour, chlorine and other issues with their waters but however they don't know many solutions or fixes to it. People know of water filters, softeners and many people use Brita filters but there education on it is very little.

Market Sophistication: Level 2, this market isn't very sophisticated on water filtration. Some people know of water softeners but not in depth. A lot of people don't even know chlorine is in their water. There aren't a whole lot of ads that target the level 2 side of this market.

Market Pains:

- “Toronto water isn't as great as its residents make it up to be. It's especially hard water which can be distasteful.”
- “Ever since this heat-wave landed I noticed the tap water suddenly smells (and tastes) more like it just came directly from the lake, with a kind of algae musk to it.”
- “My skin is so flakey after a shower”
