Step One: Log-in to Google Chrome (we need access to Chrome so that whatever changes you do today will be reflected on your computer if you download Chrome)

Step Two: Go to [Diigo.com](https://diigo.com)

Step Three: Click "Join Diigo" and then look for the Google Button. Click the Google Button and use your @bvsd.org log-in info for Google

Step Four: Add the [Chrome Extension for Diigo](#) (for ease of use)

Step Five: Explore the diigo toolbar in Chrome
