#### Primary Method - Wi-Fi Available

This document assumes that you have already set up the Microsoft
Authenticator App as you will need to use it rather than the texting method
for authentication while traveling outside the US (see "How to Set up MFA for
Students with the Authenticator App")
If you are using a Wi Ei network for Internet access, connect your mobile device

- ☐ If you are using a Wi-Fi network for Internet access, connect your mobile device (phone/tablet) to the same Wi-Fi system
- ☐ The Microsoft Authenticator app should function normally

#### **Backup Method**

- ☐ If there is no acceptable Wi-Fi connection available, please use the following steps when logging into a Harding website that prompts you for MFA
  - ☐ On your mobile device, open the Authenticator app
  - ☐ You will find your email address listed beneath Harding University

- Click on your email address. It should now show a 6-digit number under the "One-time password code"
- ☐ This code changes every 60 seconds and shows how long until it expires
