IMPORTING PHOTOGRAPHS FROM CAMERA TO LIGHTROOM

- 1. Open up Lightroom Classic on your Computer
- 2. IF your computer is logged in as someone GO HELP and sign out!

NOW you are going to log in with your School Google Account

- 3. Take your SD card out of your camera (make sure your camera is OFF). Put your SD card into your computer.
- 4. Select your SD Card at the top left menu. Navigate to the SD card and make sure those are your photos.
- 5. Minimize the Lightroom Classic window.
- 6. Open File Explorer(yellow folder) Navigate to **Documents**, create a new folder and call it **FULL NAME-Photography**
- 7. Open LR Classic again
- 8. Find your folder at the right and click on it (highlighted) Documents, photography-your name and click the check mark box by INTO SUB-FOLDER and name it with the project (ex. scavenger hunt)

Choose your destination for photos (Bottom right of screen)

- Check the subfolder box
- Give your subfolder a name
- This folder should be organized "into one folder". *Do not organize your folder by date!
- Confirm that your name is selected below under documents/OHSStudent
- Select the IMPORT button (bottom right of screen) to begin importing your photos.
- 9. Select the Import Button (Bottom left of screen) and select COPY (Make sure "COPY" is selected in white (top middle of screen)
- 10. Select your SD card photos you want saved on the computer
- 11. SAFELY eject your SD card, go to the bottom right of the computer and click on the arrow, click on the symbol that looks like a thumb drive and click SAFELY EJECT SD CARD.
- 12. Put your SD cards back in your camera.
- 13. Make sure when you're done in LR classic you go to **HELP and sign out**.

NOW GO to Anna's Website and Photo DROP in Google to YOUR FOLDER ALL YOUR PHOTOS. Do not cull your photos. I want to see everything you took.
