

Covid-19 Volunteer/Staff Agreement

- 1. Neighborhood Homework House highly recommends vaccination. As in all other cases, individuals should choose their own risk mitigation strategy.
- We will be following the <u>Los Angeles County Post Surge Plan</u> as it relates to masking. If masking becomes necessary again per LA County guidelines they will be made available to you at NHH.
- 3. If you have been exposed to COVID-19, we ask that you follow exposure guidelines per LA County Department of Public Health guidelines which can be found <u>HERE</u>.
- 4. Please adhere to the CDC guidance for domestic and international travel based on your vaccination status. You can find guidance <u>HERE</u> for international and <u>HERE</u> for domestic.
- 5. If you have COVID-19 symptoms please do not come to Neighborhood Homework House to volunteer or work. Be sure to email your immediate supervisor to let them know you will not be attending. Be sure to follow local guidelines about testing. If you have been to NHH within 2 days of the onset of symptoms please immediately notify Program Director Stephanie D'Avirro, stephanie@onhh.org.
- 6. If you test positive for Covid-19 within 2 days of being at NHH please immediately notify Program Director Stephanie D'Avirro, stephanie@onhh.org.
- 7. If you are at Neighborhood Homework House at the onset of symptoms please let a staff member know and immediately leave the campus. If you need to wait for a ride, you may use our isolation room in the interim.
- 8. Please remember that health matters are confidential and we request any discussion about your exposure or potential risk to be handled privately. Likewise, we will not disclose the health information of students, their families, staff, and other volunteers.
