TREATY OF PEACE IN THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA (TREATY OF DENVER)

Treaty and protocol signed at Denver November 6, 2068

THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, CALIFORNIA, TEXAS, OKLAHOMA, LOUISIANA, MISSOURI, IOWA, OHIO, PENNSYLVANIA, NEW JERSEY, CONFEDERATE STATES OF AMERICA, NATIONAL LIBERTY FRONT,

THE HIGH CONTRACTING PARTIES,

Agree to this Covenant of the United Nations:

The boundaries of California will be determined as follows:

1. With the National Liberty Front:

From the state borders of Oregon with Idaho, then of Nevada with Idaho and Utah, then of Arizona with Utah, then of New Mexico with Colorado until the county of Rio Arriba.

With Texas:

The frontier separated by the Rio Grande river.

3. With Canada:

The frontier of October 18, 1867.

Treaty;

thence in Washington:

The frontier made up of the counties of Whatcom; Skagit; Chelan; Douglas; Grant; and Benton and westwards to be ceded to California.

thence in the Pacific Ocean:

All United States territory, including Hawaii, to be ceded to California.

The boundaries of Texas will be determined as follows:

1. With California:

The frontier separated by the Rio Grande river.

2. With the National Liberty Front:

The frontier of the state borders between New Mexico and Colorado.

3. With Oklahoma:

The state borders of New Mexico and Texas with Oklahoma.

4. With Louisiana:

The state borders of Texas with Louisiana and Arkansas.

The boundaries of Oklahoma will be determined as follows:

1. With Texas:

The state borders of Oklahoma with New Mexico and Texas.

2. With Louisiana:

The state borders of Oklahoma with Arkansas until the county of Polk.

3. With the Confederate States of America:

The state borders of Oklahoma with Arkansas until the county of Scott.

4. With Missouri:

From the state borders of Oklahoma with Missouri, then the county borders of Cherokee with Jasper.

5. With the National Liberty Front:

The state borders of Oklahoma with Colorado and Kansas until the county of Barber.

Treaty;

thence in Kansas:

The frontier made up of the counties of Harper; Summer; Cowley; Chautauqua; Montgomery; Labette; and Cherokee to be ceded to Kansas.

The boundaries of Louisiana will be determined as follows:

1. With Texas:

The state borders of Louisiana and Arkansas with Texas.

2. With Oklahoma:

The state borders of Arkansas with Oklahoma until the county of Polk.

3. With the National Liberty Front:

The state borders of Mississippi with Tennessee.

4. With the Confederate States of America:

From the frontier separating the southwest and lower delta of Arkansas southwards, then from the state borders of Mississippi with Alabama and westwards.

The boundaries of Missouri will be determined as follows:

1. With the Confederate States of America:

The state borders of Missouri with Arkansas.

2. With Oklahoma:

From the state borders of Missouri with Oklahoma, then the county borders of Jasper with Cherokee.

3. With Iowa:

The frontier from southern Iowa and southwards.

4. With the National Liberty Front:

From the state borders of Missouri with Nebraska and Kansas until the county of Crawford, then the borders of southern Iowa with Nebraska, then of west-central; metro-east; and southern Illinois with Kentucky; Indiana; and the rest of Illinois.

The boundaries of Iowa will be determined as follows:

1. With Missouri:

The frontier from southern Iowa and northwards.

2. With the National Liberty Front:

The state borders of Iowa with Wisconsin; Minnesota; South Dakota; Nebraska; and Illinois until southern Iowa.

The boundaries of Ohio will be determined as follows:

1. With the National Liberty Front:

The state borders of Ohio with Michigan; Indiana; Kentucky; and West Virginia.

2. With Pennsylvania:

The state borders of Ohio with Pennsylvania.

The boundaries of Pennsylvania will be determined as follows:

1. With Ohio:

The state borders of Pennsylvania with Ohio.

2. With the National Liberty Front:

The state borders of Pennsylvania with West Virginia; Maryland; and Delaware.

3. With New Jersey:

The state borders of Pennsylvania with New Jersey.

4. With Canada:

The state borders of Pennsylvania with New York.

Treaty;

thence in the northeast:

The states of New York; Connecticut; Rhode Island; Massachusetts; Vermont; New Hampshire; and Maine to be ceded to Canada.

The boundaries of New Jersey will be determined as follows:

1. With the National Liberty Front:

The state borders of New Jersey with Delaware.

2. With Pennsylvania:

The state borders of New Jersey with Pennsylvania.

3. With Canada:

The state borders of New Jersey with New York.

The boundaries of the Confederate States of America will be determined as follows:

1. With the National Liberty Front:

From the state borders of North Carolina with Virginia; Tennessee; Georgia; and South Carolina, then of Alabama with Tennessee; Georgia; and Florida, then of Arkansas with Tennessee.

2. With Missouri:

The state borders of Arkansas with Missouri.

3. With Oklahoma:

The state borders of Arkansas with Oklahoma.

4. With Louisiana:

From the frontier separating the southwest and lower delta of Arkansas northwards, then from the state borders of Mississippi with Alabama and eastwards.

Treaty;

thence in Alabama:

The counties of Mobile and Baldwin to be ceded to the National Liberty Front.

The boundaries of the National Liberty Front will be determined as follows:

1. With California:

From the state borders of Idaho with Oregon and Nevada, then of Utah with Nevada and Arizona, then of Colorado with New Mexico until the county of Rio Arriba.

2. With Texas:

The state borders of Colorado with New Mexico until the county of Rio Arriba.

3. With Oklahoma:

The state borders of Colorado and Kansas with Oklahoma until the county of Barber.

4. With Missouri:

From the state borders of Nebraska and Kansas with Missouri until the county of Crawford, then the borders of Nebraska with southern Iowa, then of Kentucky; Indiana; and Illinois with west-central; metro-east; and southern Illinois.

5. With Iowa:

The state borders of Wisconsin; Minnesota; South Dakota; Nebraska; and Illinois with Iowa until southern Iowa.

6. With Ohio:

The state borders of Michigan; Indiana; Kentucky; and West Virginia with Ohio.

7. With Pennsylvania:

The state borders of West Virginia; Maryland; and Delaware with Pennsylvania.

8. With New Jersey:

The state borders of Delaware with New Jersey.

9. With Louisiana:

The state borders of Tennessee with Mississippi.

10. With the Confederate States of America:

From the state borders of Virginia; Tennessee; Georgia; and South Carolina with North Carolina, then of Tennessee; Georgia; and Florida with Alabama, then of Tennessee with Arkansas.

Treaty;

thence in North America:

The United States of America to be officially dissolved (July 4, 1776 - November 6, 2068).
