## **INTRODUCTION (Times New Roman 11, bold, required chapter structure)**

Introduction contains a narrative of the background underlying the problems raised in the research that will be explained in this article. Background also contains questions or objectives in narrative-descriptive form. The author is responsible for the suitability of the systematics and ethics of using other people's work. The background narrative does not contain plagiarism of other people's work.

Introduction can be supplemented with supporting data such as tables, diagrams, and photos. The total text in this article is 4,000 – 6,000 words. The titles of the sections should be in bold. Articles in the forms of research papers, theoretical papers, design reviews related to the journal scope.

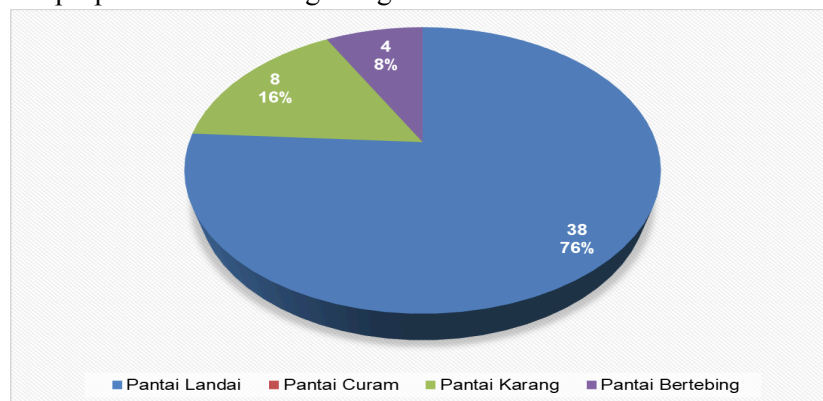


Figure 1. Image Title (Times New Roman 8pt, bold)
