

ARTICLE __ Matriculation

In light of the costs faced by Graduate Student Workers when initially matriculating (i.e., their first semester of graduate enrollment) at the University, including without limitation visa application fees (such as F and J Visa and SEVIS fees) and relocation costs, the Parties agree that each eligible doctoral student shall receive a one-time, lump-sum, matriculation support payment of Seven Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$750), subject to all applicable taxes, withholdings and deductions. The matriculation support payment will be paid within twenty (20) business days of the eligible graduate student's first-time matriculation at Cornell University as a doctoral graduate student. All doctoral graduate students who are anticipated to be a Graduate Student Worker during their course of study at the University shall be eligible for this one-time matriculation support payment. This matriculation support payment shall only be paid to Graduate Student Workers who did not previously receive a ratification payment under this Agreement. Any disputes over the ratification payment made to Graduate Student Worker, including any disputes over pay arising from or relating to such payments, shall be solely subject to the Grievance Procedures (Article X) of this Agreement.

The Union reserves the right to add to, modify, or withdraw its proposals at any time.
