- A wonderful 100th day of school was had on Feb 17
- African dancing group came in to help celebrate Black History Month
- School basketball travel team had a good season
- Started a Racism Education group for staff after we were dealing with some racist language; we have met 3 times (once Tracey Mulder- RCH Coordinator for SSRCE was in attendance); we have started to develop lessons for staff to use
- CLT- short cycles of planning and implementation goals that support our School Success Plan continues- currently in the third cycle
- Made up our own Wellness Survey for students to share how they are feeling at school
- Mi'maw Storyboard project started in March and continues; hoping to have it finished before school ends
- Common Math assessment was created by the Math CLT team; this was administered for every grade; the CLT group marked the assessments and now we are awaiting the results. A Math Data Wall is going to be made using the results
- Wikuom was vandalized; lots of support in trying to get it rebuilt. Adam and Isaac are working hard and are working closely with Elder Todd Labrador and his daughter Melissa to make sure the rebuild is what it should be
- Working with the Literacy team at SSRCE to help with moving our kids forward- specifically Grades P-2
